

RESOLUTION NO. 56-112

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township have deemed it in the best interest of public safety and welfare to employ three full time police officers, and to establish a Police Pension Fund, and

WHEREAS the past Board of Supervisors of Hopewell Township on September 12, 1955 entered into contracts of annuity and expended funds for that purpose.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, under authority contained in Act of June 24, 1931, P.L. 1206, Art XIV, Section 1415, as amended:

SECTION 1. Effective September 12, 1955 there is hereby created the Hopewell Township Police Pension Fund.

SECTION 2. The Woodlawn Trust Company, New Sheffield Branch, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, is hereby designated as the depository for such funds.

SECTION 3. Effective September 12, 1955, the Secretary of Hopewell Township, with the authority and approval of the Board of Commissioners, is authorized to enter into annuity contracts for the purpose of paying pensions or annuities to the full time regular members of the Hopewell Township police force who receive honorable discharge therefrom by reason of age or disability and the families of such as may be injured or killed in service.
