

RESOLUTION NO. 56-115

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, have deemed it in the best interest of public welfare to provide for and regulate the naming of streets and highways in said Township,

WHEREAS there exists in the Township of Hopewell, State Route 151, also known as Mixer Hollow Road, Mixture Road and Mixture Hollow Road, which road extends from the Borough of South Heights to Five Points, and

WHEREAS, the residents of this road have petitioned the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township objecting to the name Mixer Hollow Road and its variations in designation and have proposed that said road henceforth be appropriately named and known as Laurel Road.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania under authority contained in the Act of June 24, 1931, P.L. 1206, Article XV, Section 1502, as amended, do now hereby name and designate State Route 151 from South Heights Borough to Five Points as Laurel Road.
