BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Certificate of Indebtedness payable five months from the date of the same be executed and delivered to the WOODLAWN THUST COMPANY, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS, at the time of negotiation of said loan.
