

RESOLUTION No. 57-105

TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF BEAVER COUNTY:

WHEREAS, The Section of highway in Hopewell Township, County of Beaver, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, starting at a point on Crestmont Drive at Brodhead Road, its entire length to Sawyer Drive; also, Martha Street between Fifth and Seventh Avenues, being about 3,100 feet in length is in need of improvement (or) maintenance, and

WHEREAS, The Township of Hopewell desire to take advantage of the Act approved June 1, 1945, P.L. 1242, and as provided in the Act approved May 18, 1945, P.L. 803, permitting Counties of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to appropriate and expend moneys for the improvement and maintenance of State Highways and State-aid Highways or any Public Highway in any County of the Commonwealth, etc., therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Commissioners of said Hopewell Township in special session assembled on this 15th day of April, 1957, do on behalf of said Township hereby petition for County Aid as hereinbefore stated.
