

RESOLUTION NO. 58-105

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania has by Ordinance No. 58-3 imposed a four mill tax on wages and earned income under authority of the Act of June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145 and its amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Board of School Directors of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania has by resolution imposed a four mill tax on wages and earned income under authority of the Act of June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145 and its amendments; and

WHEREAS, in the best interest of the School District, the Township, the general public and all parties in interest, and in order to facilitate economic collection and administration of said respective taxes, the School District and the Township have deemed it necessary to enter into a Joint Tax Collection Agreement, providing, inter alia, for a joint Collector of said taxes.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145, as amended and Ordinance No. 58-3, that Mrs. Anne Ulmer of 1800 Cardinal Avenue, Crestmont Village, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania be and hereby is designated and appointed Collector of the taxes imposed by the Township of Hopewell under Ordinance No. 58-3. Said Collector also being the duly appointed Collector of the taxes on wages and earned income imposed by the School District, shall act as the joint Collector of said respective taxes, in accordance with the provisions contained in the Joint Tax Collection Agreement.

The compensation of said joint Collector of the respective taxes on wages and earned income imposed by the School District and the Township shall be four (4%) per centum of all such taxes collected.

The said joint Collector of taxes on wages and earned income shall furnish the School District and the Township with a Surety Company bond in the amount of \$50,000.00 in a form and with a surety to be approved by the Board of School Directors and the Board of Commissioners and their Solicitors. The premium for said bond shall be paid by the School District and the Township.
