

RESOLUTION NO. 59-103

FAMILY FLAG CRUSADE

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has duly voted the admission of the former territories of Alaska and Hawaii as the Forty-Ninth and Fiftieth States respectively, and

WHEREAS, the admission of the aforesaid former territories of Alaska and Hawaii as duly constituted states will necessitate the redesign of the union in the flag of the United States to incorporate two additional stars representing the aforesaid Alaska and Hawaii, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Pennsylvania of the Veterans of Foreign Wars is currently conducting a campaign known as the Family Flag Crusade, to encourage all citizens to obtain and display the new flag when its design has been approved by the President of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Family Flag Crusade is a patriotic endeavor to encourage and express love of country and pride in the principles and ideals associated with our National Emblem,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, approves and endorses the Family Flag Crusade and urges all citizens of Hopewell Township to join with the Department of Pennsylvania of the Veterans of Foreign Wars in furthering ownership and proper display of the New Flag of the United States containing the Forty-Ninth and Fiftieth Stars representing our Sister States of Alaska and Hawaii.
