

RESOLUTION NO. 65-103

WHEREAS, The Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act, No. 8 Special Session of 1964 provides that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will make assistance grants in the amount of fifty percent of the purchase price for land to be acquired by a political subdivision, or an agency legally created thereby, for recreation, conservation and historical purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Twp. Board of Commissioners desires to participate in the Project 70 Land Acquisition Assistance Program and to acquire the land specified in the application,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hopewell Township Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. That the Hopewell Twp. Board of Commissioners hereby approves the filing of an Application For Project 70 Land Acquisition Assistance Grant.

2. That the Hopewell Township Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file Form BCD-70-2, Application For Project 70 Land Acquisition Assistance Grant, Part I, Site and Development Proposal, with the Bureau of Community Development, Department of Commerce, as specified in said Act, and provide the information and documentation required in said application for approval of said Bureau.
