

RESOLUTION NO. 67-101

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOPWELL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the Township of Hopewell borrow the sum of Twenty Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty (\$27,250.00) Dollars from Western Pennsylvania National Bank, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, for the purpose of land acquisition in connection with the United States Open Space Program and Pennsylvania Project "70" as provided by Resoltuion No. 65-110, enacted December 13, 1965 and Resolution No. 65-105, enacted April 12, 1965.

SECTION II. The President of the Board of Commissioners and the Township Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the said sum of Twenty Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty (\$27,250.00) Dollars and to execute and deliver to Western Pennsylvania National Bank, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, a certificate of indebtedness in the following form:

CERTIFICATE OF INDEBTEDNESS IN THE SUM OF \$27,250.00

The Township of Hopewell acknowledges that it has had and received from Western Pennsylvania National Bank, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, the sum of Twenty Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty (\$27,250.00) Dollars for the purpose of land acquisition in connection with the United States Open Space Program and Pennsylvania Project "70" as provided Resolution No. 65-110, enacted December 13, 1965 and Resolution No. 65-105, enacted April 12, 1965.

In consideration whereof, the Township of Hopewell promises to pay to the order of Western Pennsylvania National Bank, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, on or before the 15th day of June, 1967, the sum of Twenty Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty (\$27,250.00) Dollars with interest at the rate of Two and 99/100 (2.99%) per cent per annum from the 17th day of March, 1967, without default.

The said Township of Hopewell covenants and agrees with the said Western Pennsylvania National Bank, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, its successors and assigns, that this Certificate of Indebtedness is issued by virtue of a resolution of the Township enacted and entered upon its minute book this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1967; that said indebtedness is incurred in conformity with law and the statutes of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania regulating the indebtedness of townships.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Township of Hopewell has caused its corporate seal to be affixed and has caused these presents to be signed by its President of the Board of Commissioners and to be attested by its Secretary this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1967.

SECTION III. The general credit and funds of the Township are pledged toward payment of the interest and principal of this indebtedness.
