

RESOLUTION No. 70-101
Areawide Planning Agency Designation

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell
(Municipality) recognizes that the Southwestern Pennsylvania Regional Planning Commission is responsible for preparing an overall plan of development for the many phases of regional planning activity (such as transportation, open space, water and sewer planning) in the six counties of southwestern Pennsylvania without assuming any existing powers or functions of the planning commissions of the local municipalities.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell
(Municipality) desires to insure a continuance of areawide planning with increased involvement of local officials in county and regional programs; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell
(Municipality) recognizes and accepts the desirability and necessity of creating a local government participation committee to the County Planning Commission or Department made up of selected representatives of the various units of local government and which committee shall have representation on the Southwestern Pennsylvania Regional Planning Commission as described in the attached Articles of Agreement among the counties of Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Washington and Westmoreland and the City of Pittsburgh for the reorganization of the Southwestern Pennsylvania Regional Planning Commission.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell
(Municipality) recognizes the need for carrying out the continuing, comprehensive transportation planning process in a cooperative manner, as required by the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1962, that will insure that the planning decisions are reflective of and responsive to both the needs and desires of the local communities and programs of the Pennsylvania Department of Highways.

the southwestern Pennsylvania area and to act as the areawide
review agency.
