RESOLUTION NO. 70-107 of 1970

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell are concerned and aware that the Woodlawn and Southern Motor Coach Company will cease operations on December 31, 1970, in the event that local affected communities do not participate in the operating deficit of the Woodlawn and Southern Motor Coach Company, and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of the County of Beaver have, by Resolution duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Beaver on December 22, 1970, agreed to participate in the operating deficit in the sum of \$4,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Aliquippa has, by Resolution duly adopted at a special meeting held on the 23rd day of December, 1970, resolved to become the applicant and participate in the deficit of the Woodlawn and Southern Motor Coach Company in the sum of \$2,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell that the Township of Hopewell will participate with the Borough of Aliquippa as the applicant, for the purchase of service grant under the Urban Mass Transportation Act, in the sum of \$1,000.00 in order to continue the transportation services rendered to the residents of the Township of Hopewell.
