

HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 71-101

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUESTING A
FLOOD PLAIN INFORMATION STUDY, UNDER
SECTION 206, FLOOD CONTROL ACT OF 1960, P.L.
86-645

WHEREAS, the municipality is in support of developing flood plain information for areas subjected to flooding by the Ohio and Beaver Rivers at no cost to the local community; and

WHEREAS, the Beaver County Planning Commission has been designated as the agency to make formal application for such surveys, said application being made to the Pennsylvania Department of Forests and Waters, through which Department such applications are channeled.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell supports the Beaver County Planning Commission in making a formal application to the Pennsylvania Department of Forests and Waters for a Flood Plain Information Study to be undertaken by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers under Section 206, Flood Control Act of 1960, P.L. 86-645 in the Township of Hopewell.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Township of Hopewell will cooperate in the survey to the extent of:

1. Assist in providing any available data and information to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers.
2. Agreeing to publicize and disseminate the results of the survey to interested parties in the community.
3. Providing the results of the Study to zoning, development and planning agencies and public

information media for their information and guidance.

4. Assist in preserving signs, monuments and other markers established during, and as a result of, the Flood Plain Information Study.

With the understanding that there will be no cost to the Township of Hopewell.
