RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ADOPTING SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN
NO. 71-104

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Pennsylvania passed the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, Act. No. 537, and it was signed into law by the Governor of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, Act No. 537 requires that each municipality in the Commonwealth shall submit to the Department of Environmental Resources, formerly the Department of Health, an officially adopted plan for sewerage systems serving areas within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of
Beaver have prepared a plan for the 54 municipalities in the County,
on a County-wide basis at no cost to the municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the portions of that plan pertaining to the Township of Hopewell have been presented by and discussed with the Beaver County Planning Commission;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell hereby agree that this plan be adopted as the official sewage plan for the Township of Hopewell and that it be submitted to the Department of Environmental Resources, formerly the Department of Health, by the County to fulfill the requirements of Act No. 537.
