

RESOLUTION NO. 74-101

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE AMOUNT OF BOND OF  
THE TOWNSHIP TREASURER.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the  
Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation of the Commonwealth  
of Pennsylvania under The First Class Township Code, AND IS  
HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That upon consideration of the petition attached  
hereto and pursuant to the authority contained in Section 801 of  
The First Class Township Code [53 P.S. § 55801], as amended, the  
bond of Norman R. Jones, duly elected Treasurer of the Township  
of Hopewell is hereby fixed in the sum of \$2,300,000 per annum,  
during his elected term of office.

2. That the Treasurer shall file with the Township  
Secretary a single fidelity bond in the aforesaid principal amount  
for the use of the County of Beaver, the Township of Hopewell and  
the Hopewell Area School District.

3. That said fidelity bond shall be subject to the  
approval of the Township Solicitor both as to form and as to the  
sufficiency of corporate surety therefor.

BOND OF THE TREASURER

TREASURER'S PETITION TO SET BOND

Pursuant to Section 801 of The First Class Township Code [53 P.S. § 55801], as amended, NORMAN R. JONES, duly elected Treasurer of the Township of Hopewell, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereby petitions the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell to fix the amount of his bond and with respect thereto represents as follows:

1. That your petitioner was duly elected to the office of Treasurer of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for a term of four years, commencing on the first Monday of January, 1974, and has duly qualified for office except for the filing of a tax collector's bond as required by statute.

2. That pursuant to Section 801 of The First Class Township Code [53 P.S. § 55801], as amended, your petitioner is the collector of taxes imposed by the County of Beaver, the Township of Hopewell, and the Hopewell Area School District.

3. That the current certified assessed valuation of real estate which may be subject to the imposition of real estate taxes levied by the County of Beaver is \$24,101,769; that the said County has levied a tax of 19 mills upon real estate subject to its levy for the calendar year 1974; that your petitioner therefore estimates that the sum of \$457,934 is the largest amount which may be collected by him for the said County of Beaver during the calendar year 1974.

4. That the current certified assessed valuation of real estate which may be subject to the imposition of real estate taxes levied by the Township of Hopewell is \$24,101,769; that the said Township has levied a tax of 10 mills upon real estate subject to its levy for the calendar year of 1974; that your petitioner therefore estimates that the sum of \$241,018 is the largest amount which may be collected by him for the said Township of Hopewell during the calendar year 1974.

5. That the current certified assessed valuation of real estate which may be subject to the imposition of real estate taxes levied by the Hopewell Area School District is \$24,101,769; that the said School District levied a tax of 60 mills upon real estate subject to its levy in the school fiscal year ending June 30, 1974; that your petitioner therefore estimates that the sum of \$1,446,106 is the largest amount which may be collected by him for the Hopewell Area School District in any one year.

6. That the current certified number of taxable persons who may be subject to the imposition of per capita taxes levied by the Hopewell Area School District pursuant to Section 679 of the Public School Code of 1949 is 12,390; that the said School District levied a per capita tax of \$5.00 upon all persons subject to its levy in the school fiscal year ending through June 30, 1974; that your petitioner therefore estimates that the sum of \$61,950 is the largest amount which may be collected by him for the said Hopewell Area School District in any one year.

7. That as Township Treasurer your petitioner estimates that the sum of \$100,000 is the largest amount which may come into his hands in any single month as Township funds (other than real estate taxes, as set forth in Paragraph 4 hereof).

8. That your petitioner proposes to file a single bond with a corporate surety as directed by The First Class Township Code to cover his entire term of office.

9. That The First Class Township Code provides that the amount of the bond shall be fixed by ordinance or resolution of the Township Board of Commissioners and that the sum prescribed shall not be less than fifty per centum of the amount of the annual Township tax nor greater in amount than the aggregate of all taxes to be collected by him.

10. That the aggregate of all taxes and other revenues as aforesaid, that may be collected by your petitioner in any one year is estimated to be \$2,307,008.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner requests that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell fix the amount of his Bond as Treasurer, by ordinance or resolution, as provided in Section 801 of The First Class Township Code.


