## RESOLUTION # 74-111

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, STATING THE INTEREST AND DESIRE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF FUNDS AVAILABLE UNDER SECTION 205 OF THE FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY ACT OF 1973.

WHEREAS, Federal monies are available for a two - year period under Section 205 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973 for applying pavement markings on certain local roads; and

WHEREAS, various streets in Hopewell Township will meet the requirements since they are over sixteen (16) feet wide, have approximately 250 vehicles per day or more presently on them have not previously been painted or do not meet present pavement marking requirements, and have a surface which can be painted; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell wishes to have all roads marked in conformance with the standards of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (1971).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, and it is hereby resolved by authority of same, that the Township of Hopewell is interested in this program and wishes to take advantage of any funds which may be available.
