

RESOLUTION 74-117, 1974

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN
VALUELESS RECORDS

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Hopewell Township have in their custody certain wage and earned income tax records; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Hopewell Township have determined that certain of these tax records more than twelve (12) years old, and other records of said Township, have no value; and

WHEREAS, a descriptive list of the aforesaid valueless records are attached herewith, made a part hereof and designated as Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation, under The First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. Pursuant to the authority contained in The First Class Township Code and Act of May 9, 1947 P.L. 908, No. 250, Section 6 (65 P.S. 63.6), the within described records having no value should be destroyed.

2. That the Township Solicitor shall in accordance with law, petition the Court of Common Pleas of Beaver County, Pennsylvania, for approval to destroy these records.
