

RESOLUTION NO. 74-120, 1974

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
REQUESTING THE CONTINUATION OF FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING.

WHEREAS, Federal Revenue Sharing has enabled Townships to financially assist public safety, improve social services, provide thousands of jobs through municipal construction projects and to maintain the line on real property taxes, and

WHEREAS, the resultant improvements have benefited the lives of our citizens without the burden of additional taxation, and

WHEREAS, Federal Revenue Sharing funds are provided by the most equitable form of Taxation, primarily in proportion to the income of all citizens nationwide on a basically fair and uniform basis, and,

WHEREAS, in order to maintain and continue the present level of service to the citizenry in our townships, it is deemed necessary to continue the program of Federal Revenue Sharing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Hopewell urges the House and the Senate of the United States to continue the program of Federal Revenue Sharing.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Commissioners specifically endorses the concepts contained in House Bill 16330, sponsored by Congressman Wilbur D. Mills, and that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded forthwith to Congressman Gary Myers, and the two U. S. Senators representing Pennsylvania and that each be specifically requested to support the continuation of Federal Revenue Sharing.
