

RESOLUTION 76-119

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, STATING THE INTEREST AND DESIRE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF FUNDS AVAILABLE UNDER THE FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY ACT OF 1976.

WHEREAS, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania in an attempt to reduce the number of accidents on its Municipal Streets (or roads).

WHEREAS, THE ELECTED OFFICIALS The Board of Commissioners recognize the fact, that the Pavement Marking Demonstration Program will possibly minimize the number of accidents.
