(1955) 1944, provides for an annual allocation of Liquid Fuels Tax funds to municipalities, and requires that all funds so allocated shall be expended on roads and streets, that all materials used and work done with such funds shall conform to current specifications of the Department of Transportation or specifications approved by the Department of Transportation, and that 25% of such funds shall be used for construction, reconstruction or widening of roads and streets, bridges and drainage structures,

Reconstruct Woodcock Drive as follows:

Remove existing bituminous pavement to base course and resurface with 1½" -ID-2A binder course and 1" - ID-2A wearing course. The project is approximately 600L.F. in length having a 26 L.F. cartway. The northerly side to have a 1½ - ID-2A overlay between the cartway and sidewalk.	Less than 1,000
