

RESOLUTION 76-125, 1976

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A SUBDIVISION OF A PARCEL OF LAND OWNED BY MATTHEW DELUCA AND CHARLOTTE DELUCA, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION REGULATION OF 1958

WHEREAS, MATTHEW DELUCA and CHARLOTTE DELUCA, his wife, have requested the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell approve a proposed subdivision of their real estate on Division St. Extension, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Hopewell Township Planning Commission held on August 3,, 1976, the Commission recommended the approval thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. That a Variance in accordance with Article IV of the Hopewell Township Subdivision Regulation of 1958, as amended, is hereby granted.
2. Pursuant to the authority contained in the First Class Township Code, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code and the Hopewell Township Subdivision Regulation of 1958, the above subdivision is hereby approved.
3. The plat of the aforesaid subdivision is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
