

RESOLUTION 76-126, 1976

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL TO ENTER INTO A CO-OPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BEAVER, PENNSYLVANIA, RELATIVE TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974, P.L. 93.383 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1976 UNDER GRANT NO. B-76-UC-42-0102.

WHEREAS, Title I of the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, provides a program of Community Development block grants for urban Counties, such as Beaver County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Hopewell Township desire that Hopewell Township become a part of the County effort.

WHEREAS, under said Grant No. B-76-UC-42-0102, an approved project activity of Hopewell Woodlawn Park Neighborhood Facility (C-576-01) has been funded; and

WHEREAS, as a part of said approved project activity, it is the desire and intent of the parties hereto to jointly cooperate in said qualified project with certain acts to be done by the said party of the second part in completion thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the above recited authority, the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, do hereby agree to enter into a Co-Operation Agreement with the Commissioners of Beaver County, Pennsylvania, all the terms and conditions of said Co-Operation Agreement being attached to this Resolution and made a part hereof.
