

RESOLUTION 76-13/1976

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania has no present problems relating to solid waste collection and disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania recognizes that it may in the future have problems relating to solid waste collection and disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania believes it is necessary to have a solid waste management and disposal program that will when the need arises meet Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources regulations as set forth in Act 241:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. That the Township of Hopewell hereby adopts the Beaver County Solid Waste Plan, dated January, 1976, as prepared for the Municipalities of Beaver County by the Beaver County Planning Commission,

2. That until the said Beaver County Solid Waste Plan shall become practically and financially feasible for Hopewell Township and presents greater advantages to the residents and taxpayers of Hopewell Township than the present system, the Township shall not be obligated under any of the terms or conditions as set forth in said Plan.
