

RESOLUTION #77-107 1977

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A SUBDIVISION OF SIX LOTS ON PROPST DRIVE, KNOWN AS CORSI-PAICH PLAN, ADDITION NO. 1, OWNED BY EMIL PAICH AND JACK CORSI, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION REGULATION OF 1958, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, EMIL PAICH and JACK CORSI, have requested the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, approve a proposed a subdivision of 6 lots on Propst Drive, known as Corsi-Oaich Plan, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, at the monthly meeting of the Hopewell Township Planning Commission held on May 3, 1977, the Commission recommended the approval thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation under the First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves;

1. Pursuant to the authority contained in the First Class Township Code, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code and the Hopewell Township Subdivision Regulation of 1958, as amended, the above subdivision is hereby approved.

2. The Plat of the aforesaid subdivision is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
