A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO PARTICIPATE IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES TO BE EXTENDED TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, THE BOROUGH OF ALIQUIPPA, AND THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTER, AND TO ALL POINTS OF PICK UP AND DISCHARGE IN SAID MUNICIPALITIES, THE SAME TO BE PROVIDED BY THE GREATER ALIQUIPPA TRANSIT AUTHORITY: CONDITIONING SUCH INTENTION UPON CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS HEREIN EXPRESSED AND TO BE ESTAB-LISHED BY COMMON DECLARATION WITH THE GOVERNING BODIES OF THE BOROUGH OF ALIQUIPPA, THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTER, THE UNITED STEELWORKERS OF AMERICA, LOCAL 1211, AND THE JONES & LAUGHLIN STEEL CORPORATION: AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SOLICITOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL TO NEGOTIATE A COMMON DRAFT AGREEMENT WITH THE SOLICITORS AND/OR LEGAL COUNSEL OF THE AFORESAID BODIES TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT AND EXPRESSION OF THIS RESOLUTION AND TO CAUSE THE SAME TO BE RETURNED TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL ON OR BEFORE MAY 1, 1978 FOR CONSIDERATION AND FORMAL ACTION THEREON.
