

RESOLUTION NO. 78-125

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A CERTAIN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AND THE GREATER ALIQUIPPA TRANSIT AUTHORITY PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES IN AND THROUGH THE BOROUGH OF ALIQUIPPA, THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, AND THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTER: FIRMLY COMMITTING THE SUM OF \$7,600 TO THE GREATER ALIQUIPPA TRANSIT AUTHORITY AS THE TOWNSHIP'S ALLOCABLE SHARE OF THE AUTHORITY'S PROJECTED LOCAL DEFICIT FOR OPERATIONS DURING THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1978 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1979; AUTHORIZING THE DUE EXECUTION OF SAID AGREEMENT IN THE FORM ATTACHED BY THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, a municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania maintaining its principal office at Clark Boulevard and Circle Drive in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. THAT that certain Agreement between the Township of Hopewell and the Greater Aliquippa Transit Authority providing for public transportation facilities in and through the Borough of Aliquippa, the Township of Hopewell, and the Township of Center, the same to be operated by the Greater Aliquippa Transit Authority, and further providing for the Township's commitment of \$7,600 as its allocable share of the Authority's projected local deficit for operations during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1978 and ending June 30, 1979, a copy of which is annexed hereto and by reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

2. THAT MICHAEL A. PARISI, JR., Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement for and in behalf of the said Township of Hopewell and Ann Kobaly, Secretary of the Board, is hereby authorized to attest the due execution thereof and impress the seal of the Township thereto.

A G R E E M E N T

THIS AGREEMENT made this 8th day of June, 1978, by and between

The TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, a municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania maintaining its principal office at Clark Boulevard and Circle Drive in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Township"),

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The GREATER ALIQUIPPA TRANSIT AUTHORITY, a body politic and corporate created pursuant to the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945 maintaining its principal office at 501 Franklin Avenue in the Borough of Aliquippa, Beaver County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Authority"),

1. WHEREAS, the Authority has been incorporated by the Borough of Aliquippa and the Township of Hopewell under the laws of this Commonwealth for the purpose of providing public transportation facilities within the Greater Aliquippa Area: and

2. WHEREAS, the Authority has implemented and operated such public transportation facilities for a period of one (1) year ending June 30, 1978; and

3. WHEREAS, the Authority fully intends to continue the operation of such public transportation facilities during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1978 and ending June 30, 1979; and

4. WHEREAS, the Township of Center intends to enter into the membership of the Authority and, in consideration thereof, the Authority intends during said fiscal year to expand such public transportation facilities into the Township of Center; and

5. WHEREAS, the Authority projects that the cost of operating such public transportation facilities for said fiscal year, including the expansion thereof, shall be \$511,616; and

6. WHEREAS, the Authority projects that the operating revenues of such public transportation facilities for said fiscal

7. WHEREAS, the Authority projects that the operating deficit of such public transportation facilities for said fiscal year shall be \$340,573; and

8. WHEREAS, both the Pennsylvania Urban Mass Transportation Assistance Law of 1967 and the Federal Government provide funds to defray the costs of such public transportation facilities; and

9. WHEREAS, the Authority will make applications to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for a grant in the amount of \$113,849 and to the Federal Government for a grant in the amount of \$170,688, both to be applied to the deficit projected to result in said fiscal year; and

10. WHEREAS, as a condition governing the grants projected to be received from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Federal Government, local funds to provide the remaining projected deficit of \$56,000 must be firmly committed to the Authority; and

11. WHEREAS, the Borough of Aliquippa, the Township of Hopewell, the Township of Center, the Jones & Laughlin Steel Corporation, and the United Steelworkers of America, Local 1211 are all firmly committed to provide during the said fiscal year a sound system of public transportation as administered by the Greater Aliquippa Transit Authority;

NOW, therefore, in consideration of the firm commitment to be made by the remaining participants as set forth below, the TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, hereby agrees and firmly commits to the Greater Aliquippa Transit Authority the sum of \$7,600 for the purpose of funding the projected remaining deficit incurred by the Greater Aliquippa Transit Authority in connection with its operations during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1978 and ending June 30, 1979:

PROVIDED, however, that should the actual remaining deficit for said fiscal year be less than \$56,000, the amount above set forth for each participant, including the Township of Hopewell, shall be abated proportionately.
