## RESOLUTION #79-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING CONSTRUCTION OF WATER LINES ON TOWNSHIP ROADWAYS IN THE HILLCREST AREA PLAN BY THE HILLCREST WATER AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell has been requested by the Hillcrest Water Authority to grant it approval for the construction and/or installation of six (6) inch water lines on Township owned roadways in the Hillcrest Area Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell accepted the roadways located within the Hillcrest Area Plan by virtue of an Implied Dedication; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell as a condition to the validity of this Resolution requires that the Hillcrest Water Authority secure a bond to insure the restoration of the Township roadways which are encompassed in the water line construction. The Hillcrest Water Authority agrees that inspection in connection with the proper restoration of the roadways shall be accomplished by the Township; that if in the opinion of the Township, the roadways have not been properly restored, then the Hillcrest Water Authority shall insure the proper restoration of said roadways through its bond; and

WHEREAS, the Hillcrest Water Authority has consented to the conditions of this Resolution by affixing the signature of its authorized representative hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situate in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves:

1. That the Hillcrest Water Authority be granted approval to construct and/or install six (6) inch water lines in or on the Township roadways located in the Hillcrest Area Plan subject to the aforementioned conditions set out in this Resolution.
