RESOLUTION #79-105

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A SUBDIVISION OF A PARCEL OF PROPERTY OWNED BY JOSEPH BELICH, ET AL., BEING INDENTIFIED AS THE OLD FARMS PLAN, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND, ORDINANCE NUMBER 58-12, AS AMENDED.

- 2. That the approval of the Old Farms Plan is for recording purposes only.
