A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A SUBDIVISION OF A PARCEL OF LAND OWNED BY THOMAS A. ACQUINO ET UX, GERALD C. PAUL ET UX AND ROBERT J. STEIGERWALD ET UX IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE OF 1978.

WHEREAS, Thomas A. Acquino et ux, Gerald C. Paul et ux and Robert J. Steigerwald have requested the Roard of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell approve a proposed subdivision of their real estate located on an unrecorded, unimproved Knoll Street Extension, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania; and

- 3. Pursuant to the authority contained in the First Class Township Code, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, and the Hopewell Township Subdivision Ordinance of 1978, the above subdivision is hereby approved.
