A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A
SUBDIVISION OF A PARCEL OF LAND OWNED BY
THOMAS A. ACQUINO ET UX, GERALD C. PAUL
ET UX AND ROBERT J. STEIGERWALD ET UX IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP
SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE OF 1978.

WHEREAS, Thomas A. Acquino et ux, Gerald C. Paul et ux and
Robert J. Steigerwald have requested the Board of Commissioners of the
Township of Hopewell approve a proposed subdivision of their real estate
located on an unrecorded, unimproved Knoll Street Extension, Hopewell Town-
ship, Beaver County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, at the monthly meeting of the Hopewell Township Planning
Commission held on April 3, 1979, the Commission recommended the approval
thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of
the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class
Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby
resolves:

1. The property included in this plan is a resubdivision of the
unrecorded plan of lots referred to as Longvue Acres Extension Plan No. 2.


2. Principle access to the lots is an unimproved right of way
known as Knoll Street Extension in which property owners have a vested private
interest by virtue of a prior deed.

3. Pursuant to the authority contained in the First Class Township
Code, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, and the Hopewell Town-
ship Subdivision Ordinance of 1978, the above subdivision is hereby approved.
