

RESOLUTION 80-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING AN
EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY TO COMPLY WITH
ACT 108 OF 1979 (H.B. 1108, P.N.
2578.

WHEREAS, the Governor has signed into law Act No. 108 of
1979 on the 12th day of December, 1979, to provide for the creation of an
"EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY" by political subdivisions of the Commonwealth;
and

WHEREAS, the intent of the new law is to enable the Commonwealth
and this township to conform to the Federal unemployment compensation laws
in providing appropriate benefits to the School Crossing Guards who are
presently, or in the future may be, employed by the Township, its agencies
or successors; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the new law is also to avoid incurring
otherwise improper and excessive Unemployment Compensation costs for certain
employees, including but not limited to School Crossing Guards, during cer-
tain holiday and summer vacation periods as provided by the appropriate
school calendar.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of
the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under the First Class
Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, located in Beaver County,
Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That there is hereby created, pursuant to Act No. 108 of 1979, a new agency to be known as the "Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell effective January 1, 1980, for the purpose of employing School Crossing Guards and such other employees as may be deemed appropriate by the Board of Commissioners , and

2. That all School Crossing Guards are hereby transferred to the payroll of the "Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell" effective January 1, 1980, and shall be compensated from the accounts of said agency, all in conformity with the provisions of said Act of the Legislature, and

3. That all appropriate payroll funds, accounts and records of the township shall be hereafter transferred to, and designated as, the accounts of the "Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell", and

4. That the township's Manager/ Secretary is hereby authorized to establish a new bank account for payment of all employees of the "Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell" and to establish all other necessary and proper accounts to comply with said Act of the Legislature.
