

RESOLUTION NO. 81-109, 1981

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL
CALLING FOR THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION TO COMPLETE ROUTE 60
BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF CHIPPEWA AND THE
CITY OF NEW CASTLE.

WHEREAS, Route 60 is a public highway largely situate in the
County of Beaver and running through the Township of Hopewell; and

WHEREAS, Route 60 is a vital commercial link between the County
of Beaver and the western section of the commercial United States
beginning with the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell verily believes that the
economic growth of the County generally and the Township specifically
necessitates that Route 60 be completed so as to provide the needed
for access to the Western United States;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND THE SAME IS HEREBY RESOLVED
THAT:

1. The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is hereby
strongly requested to give immediate attention to the completion
of Route 60 as aforesaid.
