

RESOLUTION NO. 81-116

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF MONIES WITHIN THE REVENUE SHARING FUND FROM ONE SPENDING AGENCY TO ANOTHER, SAID MONIES REPRESENTING SPENDING CATEGORIES HAVING UNENCUMBERED BALANCES.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell is desirous of transferring monies within the Revenue Sharing Fund from one spending agency to another, for the reason that said spending agencies show unencumbered balances, which monies are needed in other spending categories and;

WHEREAS, said transfers are more fully set out as follows:




1. That the transfer of monies within the Revenue Sharing Fund as more fully set out above from one spending agency to another is hereby approved and authorized.


