## RESOLUTION NO. 81-119

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, COUNTY OF BEAVER, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHOR-IZING THE TRANSFER AND UTILIZATION OF LIQUID FUELS MONIES FOR THE REPAIR AND/OR MAINTENANCE OF TOWNSHIP ROADS.

whereas, The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell did at a public meeting held on May 26, 1981, unanimously agree to constitute the passage of a Resolution permitting the use of Liquid Fuels Money allocated for construction to the repair and/or maintenance of Township Roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell did advertise in the legal notice section of the Beaver County Times of its intention to consider the passage of said Resolution at the June 9, 1981, bi-monthly meeting of the Township Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the allowance of said transfer and use of such monies is specifically authorized by Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Act 20; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell are of the opinion that the Liquid Fuel Monies would be put to its best use for the repair and/or maintenance of the Township Roadways;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves:

1. That the transfer of the sum of \$21,911.00 from Account No. 35.439.10.00 (Liquid Fuel Monies) to Account No. 35.438.10.00 (Repair and Maintenance) is hereby authorized and approved.
