RESOLUTION NO. 81-123

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE POLICE PENSION PLAN BY MODIFYING THE DEFINITION OF "PARTICIPANT" AS OUTLINED IN SECTION 1.5 TO REQUIRE THAT THE PARTICIPANT COMPLETE ONE (1) YEAR OF CONTINUOUS SERVICE WITH THE EMPLOYER.

WHEREAS, the Township established a Police Pension Plan by Resolution No. 57-106 dated October 19, 1957, for the benefit of employees of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners in accordance with the right reserved to it in such plan has amended the provisions thereof from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desire to further amend the said Plan by modifying Section 1.5, definition of "Participant", by requiring that the participant complete one (1) year of continuous service with the employer,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under the First Class

Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, located in Beaver County,

Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That Section 1.5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Participant" means every person who has been regularly appointed by the Board as a permanent full-time member of the Employer's Police Department and who has completed one (1) year of continuous service with the employer.
