RESOLUTION NO. 81-126

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF MONIES WITHIN THE STATE FUND FROM ONE SPENDING AGENCY TO ANOTHER, SAID MONIES REPRESENTING A SPENDING CATEGORY HAVING AN UNENCUMBERED BALANCE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell is desirous of transferring monies within the State Fund from one spending agency to another, for the reason that said spending agency shows an unencumbered balance, which monies are needed in another spending category and;

WHEREAS, said transfer is more fully set out as follows:

To: 35.430.74 Vehicle replacement; the sum of \$27,500.00

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, specifically by the Act of June 24, 1931, P.L. 1206 as finally amended December 14, 1969, P.L. 819, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. That the transfer of monies within the State Fund as more fully set out above from one spending agency to another is hereby approved and authorized.
