## RESOLUTION NO. 82-117

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, COUNTY OF BEAVER, PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING THE MILEAGE ALLOWANCE AT 17¢ (SEVENTEEN CENTS) PER MILE PURSUANT TO ACT 35 of 1982.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell has in the past been reimbursing as approved transportation costs at the rate of 17¢ (seventeen cents) per mile pursuant to state law for the attendance of authorized Township personnel at various conferences, schools, seminars, etc.; and

WHEREAS, Act 35 of 1982 deleted the 17¢ (seventeen cents) per mile reimbursement allowance from the State Code, thus permitting the various municipalities, authorities and other political subdivisions to establish their own mileage reimbursement allowance; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to continue the mileage reimbursement allowance at the rate of 17¢ (seventeen cents) per mile.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves:

1. That the mileage reimbursement allowance for the Township of Hopewell is hereby set at 17% (seventeen cents) per mile.
