

RESOLUTION NO. 83-132

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF MONIES WITHIN THE SEWER SYSTEM FUND FROM ONE SPENDING AGENCY TO ANOTHER, SAID MONIES REPRESENTING SPENDING CATEGORIES HAVING UNENCUMBERED BALANCES

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell is desirous of transferring monies within the Sewer System Fund from one spending agency to another, for the reason that said spending agencies show unencumbered balances, which monies are needed in other spending categories, and

WHEREAS, said transfers are more fully set out as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, specifically by the Act of June 24, 1931, P.L. 1206 as finally amended December 14, 1969, P.L. 819, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. That the transfer of monies within the Sewer System Fund as more fully set out above from one spending agency to another is hereby approved and authorized.
