

RESOLUTION NO. 85-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, OBJECTING TO THE PROPOSED CURTAILMENT OF THE REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell has been the much needed recipient of Revenue Sharing Funds pursuant to the provisions of the Federal Revenue Sharing Program; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has recently expressed a desire to severely curtail and/or eliminate the Federal Revenue Sharing Program which would result in a severe financial hardship to the Township of Hopewell and other political subdivisions that benefit from said program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell wishes to go on record as being in total opposition to any proposed curtailment and/or elimination of the Federal Revenue Sharing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell desires that certified copies of this Resolution be delivered to the Western Pennsylvania Association of Township Commissioners to be considered for action at their meeting scheduled for May 2, 1985 and it is also desired that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the State Association of Township Commissioners at Harrisburg for their review and action.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. The Township of Hopewell is in strict opposition to, and hereby objects to, any proposed curtailment and/or elimination of the Federal Revenue Sharing Program.


