

RESOLUTION NO. ⁸⁵⁻¹¹⁸ 85-118

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, EXPRESSING THE TOWNSHIP'S APPROVAL OF THE PLAN SUBMITTED BY THE RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT AREA OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE WITH RESPECT TO CONTROLLING A WATER RUN-OFF PROBLEM AT THE HOPEWELL COMMUNITY PARK.

WHEREAS, the Resource Conservation and Development Area of the United States Department of Agriculture has submitted a plan to control a water run-off problem at the Hopewell Community Park; and

WHEREAS, the submitted plan would be for the purpose of attaining the following objectives: (1) control the erosion on the stream bank and shoreline of the dike within the park; (2) reduce sedimentation within Trampmill run and improve the water quality; and (3) increase the trafficability of park areas around the pond and improve park aesthetics; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell are fully in favor of proceeding with implementation of said plan as submitted by the Resource Conservation and Development Area of the United States Department of Agriculture.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. The plan submitted by the Resource Conservation and Development Area of the United States Department of Agriculture for improving the water run-off situation at the Hopewell Community Park is approved without reservation.
