

HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP

RESOLUTION 2022- 18

Be it RESOLVED that the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County does hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality.

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the Municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Hopewell Township has prepared an Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan, Special Study (hereinafter "the Plan"), which provides for: 1) upgrades to the existing Raccoon Creek and Wickham Village Water Pollution Control Facilities (WPCF) and 2) various sewer system upgrades.

WHEREAS, The Plan:

- 1) Outlines the condition of existing sewer system infrastructure
- 2) Identifies projected developments in service area;
- 3) Describes detailed evaluations for alternatives considered; and
- 4) Identifies a need for upgrades to the Golf Course Road Interceptor, Upper Raccoon Creek Interceptor, Rt 151 Sewers, and upgrades at the Wickham Village and Raccoon Creek WPCF

WHEREAS, the Township finds that the Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.
