

HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROPRIATING MONIES FROM MUNICIPAL TAXES AND REVENUES TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31st, 2023.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted according to the power and authority granted under the First Class Township Code, Act of December 14th, 1967, P.L. 819, effective January 1st, 1969.

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or as much therefore as may be authorized by law, as may be needed or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of Hopewell Township, be and the same hereby are appropriated for the purposes and objects of said Hopewell Township hereinafter specified for calendar year commencing on the first day of January, 2023 and ending the thirty-first day of December, 2023.
