ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, A FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIP UNDER THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-03 TO CONVERT THE 2023 VALUE OF ONE-HALF (1/2) MILL TO A FIXED DOLLAR VALUE OF EIGHTY NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY (\$89,260.00)

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-03 imposed a one-half (1/2) mill tax increase, approved by Referendum on November 4, 2003 by a vote of 2037 to 930, to be used solely as a contribution to the Hopewell Township Volunteer Fire Department to construct an addition to the building located at 1401 Gringo Road, Tax Parcel No. 65-050-0101-000-2; and

WHEREAS, as the result of the 2023 Countywide Revaluation in Beaver County, the value of a real estate tax mill in Hopewell Township increased substantially; and

WHEREAS, the current value of a one-half (1/2) mill in Hopewell is Eighty Nine Thousand Two Hundred Sixty (\$89,260.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance 2003-03 in order to maintain the intent of the 2003 Referendum in equalizing and bringing current the monetary value of one-half mill in 2003 to 2023 values.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, that:

Ordinance 2003-03 is hereby amended to convert the 2023 value of a one-half (1/2) mill to a fixed dollar value of Eight Nine Thousand Two Hundred Sixty (\$89,260.00) Dollars for purposes of the payment to be made by Hopewell Township to the Hopewell Township Volunteer Fire Department. All other provisions of Ordinance 2003-03 are fully preserved with the sole exception of this amendment.
