Citizen's Forum

Janis Falk, 3217 Roosevelt Ave., Hopewell Township,

Mrs. Falk confirmed with Mr. Yurcina that Roosevelt Ave. is included on the paving list this year. She lives at the end of the road and would like to ensure that it will also be paved in front of their house. The end of Roosevelt Ave. was never connected to Cleveland Ave. as originally intended. Mr. Bates will investigate what part of Roosevelt Ave. is required to be maintained by the Township.

Andy Rauch, RAR Engineering

Mr. Rauch introduced himself to the Board as the engineer heading up the new gypsum plant construction at 2204 Todd Rd.

Dave Hanne, 124 Valleyview Ave., Hopewell Township

As a follow-up from the last meeting, Mr. Hanne met with the residents on Valleyview Ave. He is asking what needs to be done to have the road paved correctly. Mr. Yurcina stated that they are planning on paving the road. Mr. Bufalini stated the engineer would need to review the area to see what can be done to try and ensure there are no drainage issues.

Mr. Kusnir confirmed that the new paving will be an improvement, but they cannot promise that all drainage issues will be fixed. However, the Township will come up with a price for a permanent fix and will share that with Mr. Hanne. This year they are estimating spending \$100,000.00 to pave the street. Mr. Kusnir stated if we take it off the list of roads to pave this year we can't promise that the budget will allow to have it added to the list next year for paving of other improvements.

Mr. Hanne asked that on behalf of the Valleyview Ave. residents the Township hold off on paving this year and reevaluate the foundation of the road next year before it is paved.

Valerie Alexander, 3190 Bradbury Dr., Hopewell Township

Ms. Alexander asked more signage to be placed at the dog park to ensure that larger dogs and smaller dogs are kept separate. She also addressed concerns of dogs not always being leashed outside the fenced area.
