Amber Gaillard, 2255 Brodhead Rd., Hopewell Township

He feels Crissman Dr. needs to be redirected. HRG Engineers confirmed that the road was surveyed and is located correctly. Mr. Michalko still wants the road moved. Commissioners Rubino and Kusnir discussed property on 151 that was suppose to be developed within a specified amount of time or could be bought back by the county.
