RESOLUTION NO. 2011-01 A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,

PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE STANDARD FEE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF ACCEPTABLE YARD WASTE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation situate in the County of Beaver and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and **IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**:

SECTION 1 That the standard fee for use of the Township Depository for disposal of Acceptable Yard Waste is hereby amended as follows:

Pick-up Trucks and Trailers less than 15 feet in length \$10.00

Dump Trucks and Trailers 15 feet or longer in length

\$30.00

SECTION 2 It is hereby declared that the intent of this fee is to defray the operation costs of the Depository while enhancing Hopewell Township's recycling program.

SECTION 3 That compliance with all existing Rules and Regulations, to include lawful orders by the Depository Guard on duty, must be met. Anyone who fails to comply shall be subject to expulsion from future use of the Depository.

SECTION 4 Definitions: "Acceptable Yard Waste:" That yard waste which is deemed suitable for compost by the Depository Guard on duty.

SECTION 5 Any business, partnership, corporation or individual that engages in the collection, transportation, removal or disposal of Acceptable Yard Waste for profit is prohibited from using the Depository.

SECTION 6 Any Resolution or any provision of any Resolution conflicting with this Resolution and the fees established herein is hereby repealed.

This Resolution shall be effective the 14th day of March, 2011.
