

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-13
A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF ACCEPTABLE YARD WASTE AT
THE TOWNSHIP DEPOSITORY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation situate in the County of Beaver and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and **IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:**

SECTION 1 That Resolution No. 2011-12 is hereby rescinded.

SECTION 2 That Hopewell Township residents, upon providing proof of residency, shall be permitted to use the Township Depository for disposal of Acceptable Yard Waste at no cost on an interim basis.

SECTION 3 That compliance with all existing Rules and Regulations, to include lawful orders by the Depository Guard on duty, must be met. Anyone who fails to comply shall be subject to expulsion from future use of the Depository.

SECTION 4 Definitions: "Acceptable Yard Waste:" That yard waste which is deemed suitable for compost by the Depository Guard on duty.

SECTION 5 Any business, partnership, corporation or individual that engages in the collection, transportation, removal or disposal of Acceptable Yard Waste for profit or commercial purposes is strictly prohibited from using the Depository regardless of residency.

SECTION 6 Any Resolution or any provision of any Resolution conflicting with this Resolution is hereby repealed.

This Resolution shall be effective the 9th day of May, 2011.
