## S.R. 3009, SECTION 000 SANITARY SEWER LINE RELOCATION AT TRAMP MILL RUN (JV 456)

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST TO PENNDOT FOR COSTS INCURRED RELATIVE TO A SANITARY SEWER LINE RELOCATION AT TRAMP MILL RUN, STATE ROUTE 3009, WITH PENNDOT PAYING 100% OF THE ACTUAL COSTS LOCATED OUTSIDE OF PENNDOT'S RIGHT-OF-WAY AND 75% OF THE ACTUAL COSTS LOCATED INSIDE OF PENNDOT'S RIGHT OF WAY.**


In accordance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Design Manual - Part 5, Section 8.1.C, Hopewell Township does hereby authorize the submission of the attached request for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to provide seventy-five percent (75%) reimbursement to Hopewell Township for all costs incurred in relocating our sanitary sewer interceptor facilities affected within public rights-of-way by the S.R. 3009, Section 000 highway improvements project necessitated by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

Furthermore, it is understood that the Department of Transportation would reimburse Hopewell Township 100% of the actual costs of adjusting the existing facilities which are located outside of public rights-of-way, for our sanitary sewer line facilities affected by the S.R. 3009, Section 000 highway improvements project necessitated by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

Also, the President of said Township be authorized and directed to sign an agreed upon Utility Reimbursement Agreement on its behalf and that the Manager be authorized and directed to attest the same.
