RESOLUTION NO. 2017-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO RESCIND ORDINANCE 74-4 ENTITLED "ESTABLISHING A RECREATION BOARD," APPROVED OCTOBER 14, 1974, AND CREATE A PARK ADVISORY BOARD WHICH SHALL BE A RECOMMENDING BODY TO THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WITH THE TOWNSHIP COMMISSIONERS RETAINING ALL OF THE POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES SET FORTH IN THE FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE, 53 P.S. § 58009 AND 58011

On October 14, 1974 the Board of Commissioners for Hopewell Township adopted Ordinance No. 74-4 which established a Recreation Board to equip, supervise and maintain parks, recreation areas and facilities and to conduct recreation programs in the Township of Hopewell; and

Pursuant to the First Class Township Code, the Board of Commissioners may adopt or repeal Ordinances in which general or specific powers of the Township may be exercised and; and

The Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township has determined that it shall retain all of the powers and responsibilities set forth in the First Class Township Code at 53 P.S. § 58009 through 58011 and the existing Recreation Board shall hereafter be known as the Park Advisory Board acting strictly in an advisory/recommending capacity to the Township.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>13</u> th day of November, 2017 that Hopewell Township, through its Board of Commissioners, hereby repeals Ordinance 74-4 in its entirety effective immediately. A Park Advisory Board is hereby created to provide the Board of Commissioners with advice and recommendations relative to Township recreation facilities.
