A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPWELL RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF EMPLOYEES PENSION, ANNUITY, INSURANCE AND BENEFIT FUND OR FUNDS, TO AMEND CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE PENSION PLAN OR PROGRAM APPLICABLE TO THE POLICE EMPLOYEES OF SAID TOWNSHIP:

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell (the "Township") has established a retirement plan for certain of its employees known as the Hopewell Township Police Pension Plan (the "Plan") which was adopted pursuant to Act 600; and

WHEREAS, the Township reserves the right to reduce or eliminate Participant Contributions below the mandated rate of five percent (5%) of compensation subject to certain conditions on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the Township has received confirmation from the Plan's Actuary with respect to the Participant Contributions and the actuarial soundness of the plan; and

WHEREAS, the Township is satisfied upon the receipt of the Actuary's Report that the conditions have been met in order to reduce the contribution rate to 0% of compensation for the 2010 plan year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 24th day of August 2009 by the Board of Commissioners that, effective January 1, 2010, and continuing through and including December 31, 2010, the amount of Participant Contributions due shall be 0% of compensation. The obligation to pay Participant Contributions pursuant to Act 600 in the amount specified therein shall resume effective as of January 1, 2011.
