Commissioner DiPietro presented the following as New Business:

- Arrangements for the Volunteer Brunch at The Fez are being finalized.

- Normally, the fireworks contractor that is used for Parkfest is either Zambelli or Pyrotechnics. We typically choose the lower proposal. Last year we used Pyrotechnics and everyone seemed pleased. The Board of Commissioners has been satisfied with both contractors. Selection will continue to be based upon proposal price.
- The Park Board is considering having a Monte Carlo Night or Night at the Races or a Small Games of Chance ticket. Attorney Mike Jones is looking into requirements and legalities of these fundraisers.
- Applications for summer employees are being received.
- Commissioner DiPietro suggested that the advertisements on the web site be separated by department within their specific header. Recently, the Fire Department advertising for their Breakfast with Santa and the Park Board advertising for their Visit with Santa were a bit confusing as portrayed on the web site.
- A request was made to Commissioner DiPietro for porta-john placement at the new tennis court, blue booth across the street from the new tennis court, public tennis courts, and Sharon Grange Playground. Discussion ensued regarding whether the Township or School schedules the delivery of the porta-johns and payment of the cost of the porta-johns. Engineer Marie Hartman will research this information.
