RESOLUTION 2013 - 05

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, A FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIP UNDER THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING AND SETTING FORTH A THRESHOLD FOR CAPITALIZATION OF ASSETS

WHEREAS, The Township of Hopewell ("Township") currently maintains a threshold for capitalization of assets of five thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Township Auditors have recommended and advised that the Township increase this threshold to Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars and the Township desires to adopt that recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township of Hopewell, in accordance with the recommendation of the Township Auditors, hereby resolves that the following policy for the capitalization of assets is adopted.

CAPITALIZATION POLICY FOR CAPITAL ASSETS

A capital asset is a piece of property that meets all of the following requirements:

- 1. The asset is tangible and complete.
- 2. The asset is used in the operation of the Municipality.
- 3. The asset has a useful life of longer than the current fiscal year.
- 4. The asset is of significant value.

Capital assets may be acquired through donation, purchase or may be self-constructed. The asset value for donations will be the fair market value at the time of the donation. The asset value, when purchased, will be the initial cost plus the trade-in value of any old asset given up, plus all costs related to placing the asset into operation. The cost of self-constructed assets will include all costs of construction.

The following threshold values will be used for the designated classes of assets:

Class of Capital Asset	Significant Value
Machinery & Equipment	\$10,000 or more
Buildings & Building Improvements	\$15,000 or more
Infrastructure & Land Improvements	\$20,000 or more
Land	Any amount

 If a department has a grant with a contractual capitalization threshold then any such requirement shall supplant and override the Township's threshold. This Resolution is effective and adopted this MAY 6th 2013 day of 2013.
